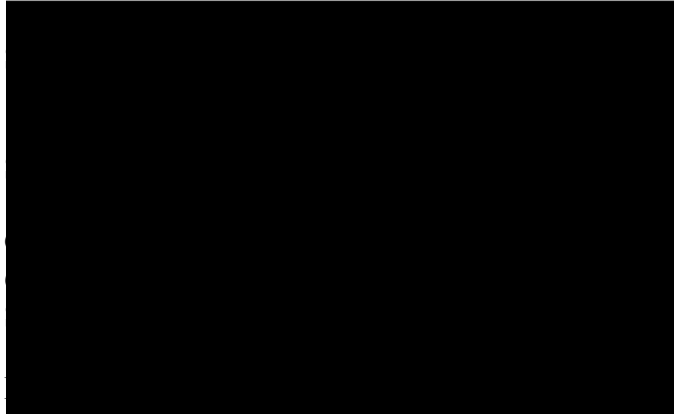



BC Government Secure File Transfer Service

Information Access Operations Ad-Hoc User Guide

Introduction

The purpose of this document is to provide the basics skills required to use the Secure File Transfer Service (SFTS) as a temporary user (also known as ad-hoc). Your account has limited functionality and can only be used to receive files from an authorized BC Government user.

How to Log on to the Service

As a temporary user of the SFTS, you must be invited to use this service by being a recipient of a sent package from an authorized user. The first time a BC Government user has sent a package to you, you will receive a welcome email notification with a temporary password to set up your account and a link to the service.

Note that your temporary account's username is your email address. The password is a temporary one and will need to be changed upon the first login.

Home Screen

Once you are successfully logged in, you will see the Home screen with your records package in your Inbox. To download your records, simply click on the records package and then click on the Download button beside the file(s). You will be able to download the package up to five times and all packages will expire 35 days after being received.

Troubleshooting

Your temporary SFTS account has an expiration timer of 7 days, unless the account is logged into again or receives a new package. After a further 7 days after your account has been marked as expired, it will be deleted. You will need to have a new ad-hoc account created by being re-invited to the service.

Passwords expire after 90 days. If you have forgotten your password, but your account is still active, you can use the "Request a password change" link on the Login page. An email will be sent to you providing you the URL to confirm the password change.

If you encounter technical issues with the service, please call the technical support line at 250-387-7000 and select option 3. You will need to advise the representative that you are requesting assistance as an ad-hoc user of the BC Secure File Transfer Service.

Impact of the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak on Surgeries, GI Endoscopy Procedures and MRIs

Preface

On Mon 2020-03-16, as a response to the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) outbreak, the Ministry of Health (the Ministry) directed health authorities to move into Outbreak Response Phase 2, postponing all non-urgent scheduled surgeries. Lions Gate Hospital in the Vancouver Coastal Health region was directed to move into Outbreak Response Phase 3, i.e., they were directed to only perform emergency surgeries.¹

“Non-urgent scheduled surgeries” refers to surgeries assigned priority levels with clinical benchmarks over six weeks for adults (or three weeks for pediatric cases).

In addition, the Ministry directed that the same Phase 2 Outbreak Response action be applied to gastrointestinal endoscopies (GI endoscopies), medical imaging and ambulatory care.

Technical Notes

The number of days in period 01 and 13 as well as the periods in which statutory holidays fall may differ between fiscal years. Discretion should be exercised when comparing period results between fiscal years, particularly periods 01 and 13.

For non-urgent scheduled surgeries, the productivity per business day is about 19% (115/607) compared to the previous fiscal year. For urgent scheduled surgeries, the productivity per business day is about 62% (206/333) compared to the previous fiscal year. 2019 did have more average unscheduled surgeries per day compared to 2020, which is likely a product of reduced economic activity from the stay at home directive. The reduction in surgeries per day for unscheduled, urgent scheduled and non-urgent scheduled can be seen in the chart below.

Wait List Management

9. Are non-urgent surgeries being rescheduled as urgent surgeries? Are non-urgent surgeries being completed as unscheduled surgeries?

These questions will be investigated in a future analysis.

Surgical Analysis

Provincially, wait lists increased slightly for urgent surgeries (+1.7%) and non-urgent surgeries (+1.6%) in 2019/20 P13 compared to the previous period and may be attributable to responses to COVID-19, including postponements of non-urgent scheduled surgeries part way through P13 as well as reports of fewer booking forms being sent to health authority booking offices as surgeons' offices have been closed.

Wait times (measured as % waiting over benchmark) increased (worsened) provincially for urgent surgeries (+7.0 percentage points) and non-urgent surgeries (+2.0 percentage points) in 2019/20 P13 compared to the previous period. Similarly, wait times (measured as % waiting over 26 weeks) also increased (worsened) provincially for hip and knee replacements (+1.5 percentage points), dental surgeries (+0.9 percentage points) and all other surgeries (+1.8 percentage points) in 2019/20 P13 compared to the previous period.

Provincially, the number of non-urgent scheduled surgeries completed in P13 decreased significantly (-44.8%) in 2019/20 as compared to the same period the previous fiscal year. Amongst health authorities, the decrease ranged between -32.8% (FHA) and -51.3% (IHA).

What was not expected was the decrease in cases completed observed provincially for unscheduled surgeries (-7.2%) and urgent scheduled surgeries (-18.2%), which were not included in the directive for all but one hospital (Lions Gate Hospital). For unscheduled surgeries, the decrease can be attributed to VCHA who experienced a -26.5% decrease in cases completed in 2019/20 P13 compared to the same period the previous fiscal. For urgent scheduled surgeries, the decrease ranged between -8.5% (FHA) and -24.6% (IHA) amongst health authorities.

Provincially, non-urgent surgeries completed for hip and knee replacements (-46.5%) and dental (-59.7%) were impacted to a greater degree than all other surgeries (-43.6%) in 2019/20 P13 when compared to the same period the previous fiscal year. Urgent surgeries completed for hip and knee replacements (-58.4%) and dental (-42.9%) were impacted to an even greater degree than all other surgeries (-16.7%) in 2019/20 P13 when compared to the same period the previous fiscal year.

Overarching the observations outlined above for surgeries completed is the difference in the number of days in 2019/20 P13 (26 days) compared to 2018/19 P13 (24 days). Absent the directive, the additional 2 days of surgeries in 2019/20 P13 would have translated into more completed unscheduled, non-urgent and urgent surgeries than in 2018/19 P13.

GI Endoscopies

Postponements

1. Since the implementation of Outbreak Response Phase 2 (Phase 3 at Lions Gate), how many GI endoscopy procedures have been “postponed”?

Health authorities recently began submitting record-level data on GI endoscopies to the SPR. The Ministry continues to collaborate with health authorities to resolve data quality and reporting issues. Reporting of GI endoscopy postponements will commence upon resolution of these issues. Postponements are not reported as part of the data manually submitted to the Ministry each period.

Cases Waiting

GI Endoscopy Analysis

As with surgical procedures, wait lists increased for colonoscopies (+1.8%) and other GI endoscopies (+1.9%) in B.C. in 2018/19 P13 when compared to the previous period and is likely attributable to a similar response as surgical to COVID-19. Wait times (measured as % waiting over benchmark) also increased (worsened) provincially for both colonoscopy procedures (+3.1 percentage points) and other GI endoscopy procedures (+4.3 percentage points) in 2019/20 P13 when compared to the previous period.

The number of colonoscopies completed provincially in P13 decreased significantly (-44.0%) in 2019/20 P13 compared to the same period the previous fiscal year. The decrease ranged between -37.9% (IHA) and -54.6% (VCHA) amongst health authorities.

Provincially, the number of other GI endoscopies completed in P13 decreased significantly (-30.3%) in 2019/20 P13 compared to the same period the previous fiscal year. Amongst health authorities, the decrease ranged between -17.8% (NHA) and 38.6% (VCHA).

Overarching the observations outlined above for colonoscopies and other GI endoscopies completed is the difference in the number of days in 2019/20 P13 (26 days) compared to 2018/19 P13 (24 days). Absent the directive, the additional 2 days in 2019/20 P13 would have translated into more completed colonoscopies and other GI endoscopies than in 2018/19 P13.

MRIs

Postponements

1. Since the implementation of Outbreak Response Phase 2 (Phase 3 at Lions Gate), how many MRI encounters have been “postponed”?

The Ministry continues to collaborate with health authorities to resolve data quality issues related to reporting MRI postponements. Expectation is to report postponements in 2020/21 Period 1.

MRI Analysis

The volume of MRI exams in 2019/20 P13 decreased at all HAs (except IHA) and in B.C. overall compared to 2018/19 P13, despite P13 having two more days in 2019/20 (26 days) compared to 2018/19 (24 days). Compared to 2018/19 P13, the volume in 2019/20 P13 is lower by between 12% (FHA) and 35% (VCHA), and the overall volume in B.C. is lower by 19%. The volume of MRI exams decreased the most at VCHA, partially due to a 40% decrease in volume of exams at Lion's Gate Hospital in 2019/20 P13 (410 exams) compared to 2018/19 P13 (687 exams), reflecting the move to Outbreak Response Phase 3 at this facility. The volume at IHA increased by 12% in 2019/20 P13 compared to 2018/19 P13, as a new MRI unit began operation in September 2019 at Vernon Jubilee Hospital. Excluding the volume of MRI exams at Vernon Jubilee Hospital, the overall volume of exams at IHA decreased from 2,002 in 2018/19 P13 to 1,827 in 2019/20 P13 (a 9% decrease).

MRI wait times performance (measured as % of encounters completed within benchmark) increased (improved) provincially by 5.0 percentage points in 2019/20 P13 compared to the previous period. Wait time performance increased at all HAs, with increases ranging from +1 percentage point (NHA) to +9 percentage points (VIHA).

Appendix A: Capturing COVID-19 Postponements in the Data

Surgical

Health authorities were directed to record COVID-19 postponed surgeries as follows:

- For health authorities that use postponement codes, Postponement P15 Disaster should be used.
- For health authorities that are unable to use postponement codes, Cancellation C12 Disaster – Postponement/Duplicate should be used.

When a surgery is “postponed,” the patient remains on the waitlist for their surgeries. When a surgery is cancelled, the patient is removed from the waitlist.

Postponements are counted from the date the procedure was postponed (surgery deferred date), not when a procedure was originally scheduled to be completed (scheduled surgery date). Only one postponement is reported per case.

Known data quality issues:

- NHA: not capturing surgery deferred date.
- IHA: not sending correct postponement data to the SPR due to a coding issue in the SPR extract. Issue is now fixed, but data won't be available in SWTP until 2020/21 P01; however, it will be available in the SPR as of April 21, 2020.

UPDATE 2020-04-24: Health authorities have been asked to submit surgical postponement and completion data on weekly basis to Health Emergency Coordination Centre (HECC).

GI Endoscopy

Health authorities are submitting GI endoscopy data to the SPR. However, in the interim, health authorities continue to manually report data. As manual data submissions are aggregate numbers, unable to report postponements.

UPDATE 2020-04-24: Health authorities have been asked to submit GI endoscopy postponement and completion data on weekly basis to Health Emergency Coordination Centre (HECC).

Medical Imaging

Booking postponements and suspensions are similar: a patient must wait longer for their booking due to the COVID-19 response, but they do not need a new requisition from the referring physician. The difference in terminology is to allow the MIWT database to capture the information received from different health authority booking systems.

Postponements: When a booking is postponed, its provincial status [CSV1] is still “Active” in the MIWT. For the booking, a postponement date [CSV36], postponement reason [CSV37] and a new procedure scheduled date (if available, [CSV33]) are reported to the MIWT. Postponed bookings in MIWT are identified with a Provincial Postponement Code of P5 – Disaster and counted by the fiscal period when the booking status was changed to postponed (i.e., Procedure Postponed Date [CSV36]). This is occurring in the following health authorities: IHA, VIHA, VCHA (Cerner), PHSA

Suspensions: When a booking is cancelled but not a requisition, the booking is reported as a cancellation to the MIWT. To indicate that a booking is cancelled, a provincial status [CSV1] of “Cancelled,” a procedure cancelled date [CSV34] and cancellation reason [CSV35] must be submitted to the MIWT. Suspended bookings in MIWT are identified with a Provincial Cancellation Code of C8 – Disaster and counted by the period when the booking status was changed to cancelled (i.e., Procedure Cancelled Date [CSV34]). This is occurring in the following health authorities: FHA, NHA, VCHA (Cerner, IDXRad)

Known data quality issues:

- PHSA: able to report postponement data for 2019/20 P13; aim to deliver P13 postponement data with 2020/21 P01 data
- VIHA: technical difficulties delayed 2019/20 P13 postponement data delivery until after snapshot deadline; 2019/20 P13 postponement data will be reported when 2020/21 P01 data is available.
- IHA: technical difficulties delayed 2019/20 P13 postponement data delivery until after snapshot deadline; 2019/20 P13 postponement data will be reported when 2020/21 P01 data is available.
- NHA: technical delays prevented recording of 2019/20 P13 postponement data; first available postponement data will be for 2020/21 P01.
