On June 17 2020, Nova Scotia Health Authority (NSHA) received your request under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy (FOIPOP) Act for a copy of the following:

Please also note that information system across NSHA differ by clinical area, as such, the availability of electronic information to respond to this FOIPOP request is limited. 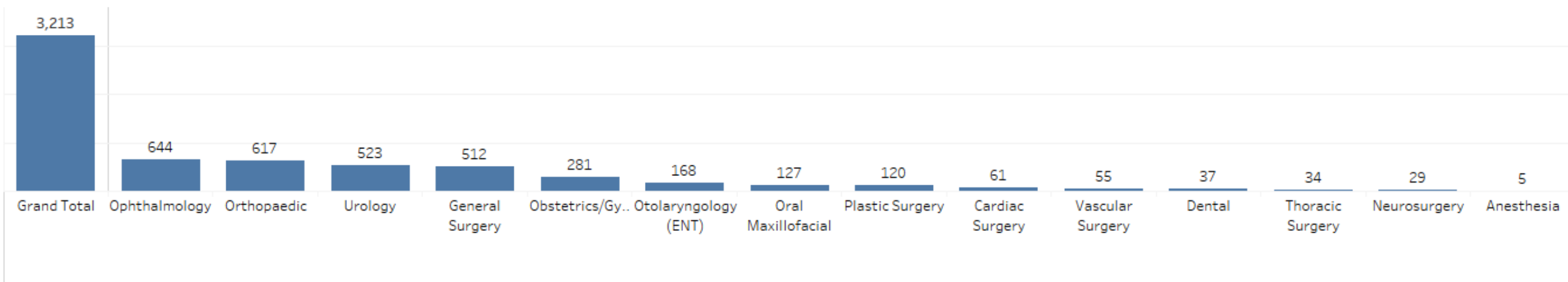

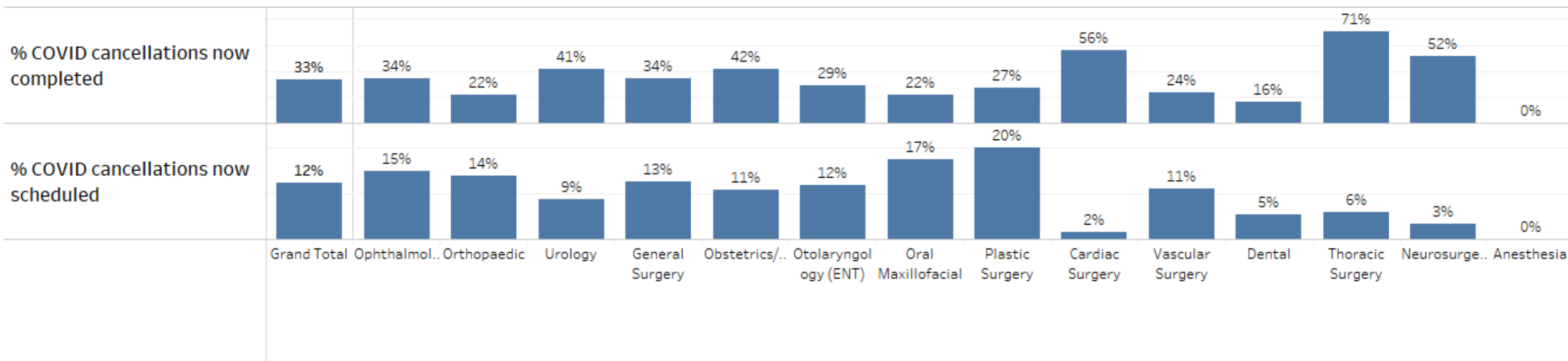
# Surgical Cancellations during COVID Slowdown
