The Department of Health has reviewed your request, received on December 20, 2022, under the Right to Information and Protection of Privacy Act about the number of patients on various waitlists.

As of Dec 5, 2022, the number of prioritized surgeries waiting is 23,416. One patient can be waiting for multiple procedures. The Department of Health does not have data related to the number of patients waiting for a diagnostic scan or appointment with a specialist.


