**Re: BC Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (“Act”)
Request for Records: VCH File 2024-F-157**

We are writing in response to your request for the following records:

Total for the number of patients that died while waiting for diagnostic scans in fiscal year 2023-2024.

In fiscal year 2023-2024, a total of 488 patients in the Vancouver Coastal Health region passed away while waiting for a diagnostic scan.

As a practice, VCH only tracks cause of death for patients on a diagnostic scan waitlist if they are actively receiving care at one of our sites. However, the total number of patients identified above also includes those who passed away while not admitted to a VCH site. As such, this data cannot be used to establish a correlation between diagnostic wait times and patient death.
